<u>"IN CHRIST IN ROMANS"</u>

The Phrase *in Christ,* is deeply meaningful for Paul and appears no less than eighty-four times in his letters, Thirteen times in his letter to the Romans

being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in
Christ Jesus;
Even so consider yourselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ
Jesus.
For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in
Christ Jesus our Lord.
Therefore there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ
Jesus.
For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the
law of sin and death
nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to
separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
I am telling the truth in Christ, I am not lying, my conscience testifies
with me in the Holy Spirit ,
so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually members
of one of another.
Therefore in Christ Jesus I have found reason for boasting on the thing
pertaining to God.
Greet Prisca and Aquila, my fellow workers in Christ Jesus
Greet Andronicus and Junias, my kinsmen and my fellow prisoners, who
are outstanding among the apostles, who also were in Christ before me
Greet Urbanus, our fellow worker in Christ, and Stachys my beloved.
Greet Apelles, the approved in Christ. Greet those who are of the
household of Aristobulus.
